Four Public Squares
- S.C. Department of Archives and History. Stack Location VI/29/1/9. Undated copy of deed of Thomas Godbold, Sr., to Hugh Giles and Robert Hodges as Commissioners of District of Marion for Lots 1 and 8 for Court House and Gaol and for four public squares and for street areas for use of public. The deed is attached to petition of Thomas Godbold, Sr., and Robert Hodges dated November 25, 1812, asking the General Assembly to protect Thomas Godbold, Sr., and the public from encroachment by private persons upon the public squares and streets given by Thomas Godbold, Sr., to the public by copy of the deed attached.
- Lot No. 5
- No deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr. First reference for number and location of Lot 5 is deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr., to Thomas T. Wickham, May 10, 1801. Book B-145, September 16, 1802, for Lot 10. First deed covering this Lot 5 is deed of Thomas Godbold, Sheriff, to John Smith, April 3, 1810, Book N-128, August 7, 1829. Sold against Patrick Donnelly.
- Lot No. 11
- No deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr. First reference for number and location of Lot 11 is deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr., to John G. and E. G. Smith, September 15, 1802, Book I-86, August 2, 1819. This deed conveys Lot 3 and gives Lot 11 (owned by E. Brown) as south boundary.
- Lot No. 15
- No deed for Thomas Godbold, Sr. First reference for number and location of Lot 15 is deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr., to Thomas Godbold, Jr., January 11, 1817, Book O-70, October 10, 1831. This deed conveys unnumbered lot on Wickham Street and gives Lot 15 as south boundary.
- Lot No. 29
- No deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr. First reference for number and location of Lot 29 is deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr., to John G. and E. G. Smith, September 15, 1802, Book I-86, August 2, 1819. This deed conveys Lot 30 and gives Lot 29 (owned by E. Brown) as south boundary.
- Lot No. 31
- No deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr. First deed for Lot 31 (exclusive of Masonic Lodge portion) is deed from Thomas Godbold to Christopher B. Brown, October 9, 1822, Book L-118, November 12, 1824. No Dower. (Records in Deed Books K-160 and K-161 show that this Thomas Godbold is General Thomas Godbold.)
- Lot No. 38
- No deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr. First reference for number and location of Lot 38 is deed from Thomas Godbold, Sr., to David Legette, March 14, 1817, Book F-442, March 17, 1817. This David Legette deed either conveys Lot 38 or conveys an unnumbered lot on Godbold Street and gives Lot 38 as boundary. Location doubtful.
